HUNTING GEAR

- Rifle (at least 30 caliber) with scope in solid case
- 30 rounds ammunition
- Binoculars
- Gun cleaning kit
- Hunting Knife
- Sharpening Stone
- Flashlight with fresh batteries
- Waterproof matches
- Small pack sack
- Shotgun if Upland Game Bird Hunting
(additional tag required)
- Hunting Boots (waterproof / warm)
- Shotgun Shells

CLOTHING

- Heavy wool or equivalent shirts
- Light wool shirt
- Pair of blue jeans
- Pair of warm pants (like wool)
- Underwear
- Long underwear
- 4 pairs of wool or equivalent socks
- Wool (or equivalent) gloves
- Insulated gloves
- Rain gear
- Warm jacket
- Camp shoes
- Warm hat

PERSONAL GEAR

- Toiletries
- First Aid Kit
- Sunglasses
- Pocket Knife
- Tobacco Products
- Insect Repellent
- Lighter with fuel, flints, etc
- Cell Phone and Charger
- Flashlight (IMPORTANT!!)
- Bulbs / Batteries

- Non-resident Firearm Declaration (RCMP 5589) completed in **triplicate**. Have this form completed and with you at the boarder for presentation to Canadian Customs. You must sign in the presence of Customs. We have provided you with 1 copy of the form, which can be duplicated upon completion.
